People who want to explore the power of collective creativity, social intelligence, and collaboration in to improve their communities, teams, and organisations.

The training will be hosted by experienced Art of Hosting practitioners from [Jeder Institute](#), [Purpose Partners](#), [Linette Harriott](#) and [Viola Tschendel](#), a collaboration committed to nourishing Participatory Leadership in Australia, and a group of emerging practitioners apprenticing at the training. Four practitioners are Victorians and others are from Queensland and Europe - all have a keen desire to bring their practice to a broader range of people in Victoria, and support the development of capacity and the community of practitioners. ## Participation fees – a sliding scale

**\$660- \$1060 (excluding GST) plus accommodation**

A question we have been exploring is how to keep costs down, and honour the diversity of economic factors that would encourage people to join us in participatory leadership work.

We invite you to be in this exploration with us as we look to build capacity in Victorian communities, cover all costs, contribute to supporting the international community and allow the hosts to receive some payment in recognition of their offering.

We offer a sliding scale of \$AU660 - \$1060 (excluding GST) that will include participation in the 3 day training, food and resources. You will also have your choice of accommodation to suit your budget when you register for this residential training, with a range of \$60 per person per night (for a quad room shared with 3 others), to \$175 per person per night (for a single corporate room).

So, with our sliding scale and accommodation options, you decide what you consider to be a fair price for this training, or within your training budget, and we also hope that you consider offering a little more which could support others to attend. If this is still beyond your capacity, please talk to us, or indicate this on your registration form. Help us walk our talk to assist as many willing people as possible to attend.
